Your Roles & Responsibilities

The link governor for finance will:

- Work closely with the Swingate business manager to monitor the financial position of the school.
- Ensure the school has an up-to-date finance policy.
- Ensure all other finance policies are up to date and that they are being followed (Charging and Remissions, Pay and Governor allowance and expenses).
- Know how your school's financial position compares with similar schools
- Be aware of local and national developments that would affect your finances, e.g. an increase in National Insurance contributions.
- Attend relevant training to keep up to date with current thinking.
- Meet with the Headteacher to ensure finance are linked to the School Improvement Plan
- Work with other link governors whose role involves finance such as Pupil premium and SEND).

Questions to ask senior leaders

Its not just up to you to ask finance questions, all governors should ask questions and should be encouraged to do so.

Ofsted will look to see that governors oversee financial performance and make sure money is well spent. See paragraphs 345 and 346 of Ofsted's School Inspection Handbook.

They'll also look for evidence that your role as a link governor is <u>performed effectively</u>.
