Year 5 Residential Trip to Bude

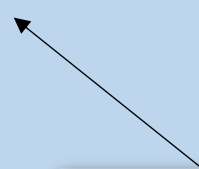


This was our fifth successful visit, and what a fantastic trip it was! Despite the very hot weather, the children had a wonderful time enjoying activities such as mountain boarding,
